Thank you to everyone who has completed the consent form for our mass testing programme which we are bringing forward to next week in order to get everyone back into learning as early as we can, in the safest way possible.

Parents/Carers of Y11 and Y13 students only

Please look out for a letter from me tomorrow (Friday) once we have digested the news today on GCSE and A level qualifications. Despite the leakages in the press today, the secretary of state for education is not making his announcement in The Commons until later and we want to be sure that we have all of the correct facts at our disposal and not a press interpretation of them.

As promised yesterday here is the detailed plan for getting all of our students back into full time learning by Monday 15th March.

Please read this very carefully with your child(ren) so that they arrive at school on the right day, at the right time for their tests.

Instructions

- ✓ Students should come to school with a mask. They are not required to wear school uniform
- ✓ Mass testing will take place in the Sports Hall.
- ✓ Students should arrive at their allotted time and go straight to the front entrance of the sports hall where they will be greeted by a member of the testing team
- ✓ They will then be guided through the testing process
- ✓ Students will then leave by the back door of the sports hall and will need to go straight back home. It is important that we all remember that, whilst students are returning to school, all other lockdown restrictions remain, including socialising inside or outside with members of other households. In my meeting with the police yesterday they are concerned about the number of young people they are now seeing in the streets of Banbury and in the local parks who are obviously not in family groups.
- ✓ If your child tests positive you will be notified immediately and you will be required to take your child for a PCR test (Wood Green is still conducting these)
- ✓ If your child's test is negative we will not be contacting you.







You will need to make sure that you know which mentor group your child(ren) is/are in e.g. C1 is Charlecote 1 a year 7 mentor group.

If your child is in Year 11 please make sure that they are clear which maths group they are in.
