Dear Parent/Carer

This week has seen our Muslim students and their families celebrating Eid, following the Ramadan period which started on 12<sup>th</sup> / 13<sup>th</sup> April. We messaged them all to say Eid Mubarak and hope they had a blessed time.

You will all be aware that Monday 17<sup>th</sup> May sees the next step in the relaxation of Covid restrictions across the country. I am certain that we have all been looking forward to this day for months now. Below I will outline our response to this.

### Face coverings

The government have given further *guidance* to schools regarding the wearing of face coverings in school. We have discussed this as a senior team and are going to adopt the following from Monday 17<sup>th</sup> May.

We will monitor numbers of positive cases in the Cherwell District on a daily basis and respond accordingly. If numbers increase again we **may** return to wearing face coverings in classrooms. If numbers decrease further we **may** move to no face coverings anywhere in school.
