Monday 17th May - Year 9 check

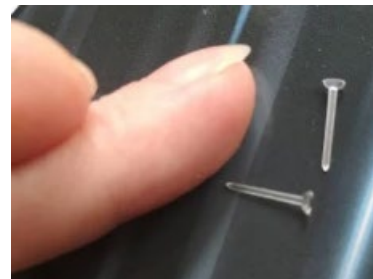
Monday 24th May – Year 8 check
